## Who Are We?

A group of social-minded volunteers founded the Corner Cupboard, a non-food pantry, dedicated to providing essentials to families and individuals living in York County, the most populated and fastest growing county in Maine. This grassroots organization is sponsored and housed in the Sanford Unitarian Universalist Church.

The Corner Cupboard's primary goals are to assist people in meeting their basic needs for living and to fill in the gap for those who are struggling. We work collaboratively with other service agencies in the area. The Corner Cupboard is dedicated to honoring the integrity and worth of all individuals. We do not discriminate based on race, religion, color, age, sex, disability, national origin or political affiliation or need.

The Corner Cupboard offers non-food items including personal care, paper, cleaning, household, baby and pet products. We also have gently used clothing and household items.



## History

During our first week of operation in February of 2006, we served 30 families. We now assist 150 - 200 families monthly. The cost of this operation is \$800.00 - \$1,000.00 per month. We shop online and locally and are often given donations and assistance by area businesses.
